## Gestures

Tap: Is the most basic gesture. Tap finger on what is wanted to interact with. Tap to open an app, issue a command, or follow a hyperlink. To enter text, tap a text field to begin editing, a keyboard appears then tap keys to type.  Multitasking Gestures: It is used	Drag: Place finger on the iPad's screen, then drag it across the screen.
