The Choice Academy focuses upon social, global, and environmental responsibility using a Service Learning Model.

The annual Days of Service are held throughout the school year. The Days of Service vary, thematically focused at different times of the academic year. The Freshman Day of Service involves fall landscaping and/or beautification project while hunger is the theme near Thanksgiving with the Million Meal Movement. Civil rights projects celebrate Martin Luther King Day and projects with Global Youth Service Day wrap up the year. The sophomores work on environmental issues in EASEi. Juniors develop their own social projects in Social Action along with running the Choice Academy Food Pantry and Clothes Closet. The seniors engage in various projects involving human rights issues. Many of the senior projects originate in PEP, a double-blocked class that integrates U.S. Government, State & Local Government, Economics, and a Topic in Social Science course.

The Choice Academy sponsors an Earth Day Museum each April, displaying projects created by students in the Environmental Science and PEP classes. Students in the Environmental Science class also provide recycling of plastic, aluminum, and electronics throughout the school year. Students in the Choice Academy provide recycling of used electronics throughout the year.
