IDEAS Strategic Plan Overview: Building on our foundations.


Foundation 2:

IDEAS students have completed projects that show a deep understanding of concepts and strong literacy and reasoning skills. Students will develop digital portfolios that document their growth as learners to be used to show colleges and employers how they are prepared for the opportunities in front of them.

Foundation 3:

IDEAS students have a strong history of success on measures of achievement. A system of monitoring academic progress will be developed to ensure students are matriculating appropriately through our academic program.

Foundation 1-Students will acquire the skills necessary to reach the deeper levels of understanding and reasoning as presented by Webb's Depth of Knowledge and the New Bloom's Taxonomy.



Action Step:

Students will use Smekens literacy strategies in all courses to improve their literacy skills in order to be independent learners.

Action Step:

Students in all courses will use the 6 step problem-solving process or the PLTW Design process to gain a stronger understanding of how to independently and collaboratively solve problems.

Action Step:

Collaborative planning and review processes will be used by IDEAS faculty to ensure that projects are rigorous, focused on the elements of College and Career Readiness and properly scaffolded so that all learners are successful.

Action Step:

A data team will be formed consisting of teachers and counselor that monitors overall academic performance.

Action Step:

The data team will develop a protocol/process to track individual student acquisition of credits.

Action Step:

An intervention process that involves parents, CCR teachers, and administration/counselor will be developed that allows IDEAS to address students that are not matriculating at an appropriate rate.

Action Step:

A formal process of recognizing academic achievement and improvement will be developed and used during Family Friday and celebrated on various forms of media.

Assessing Our Work

Foundation 1 and 3

IDEAS Data Team: The data team, consisting of counselor and 3 teachers, will develop a process of monitoring the work IDEAS' staff and students are doing as it relates to both foundations. The process will contain the following:

- Recommended process for collecting data
- Quarterly reports to IDEAS staff and students
- Identification of best practices
- Recommendations for shifts in pedagogy
- Recognition of positive movements by school, staff and students

Foundation 2

Portfolio Team: A Portfolio team will be created preferably consisting of a business partner, an admissions specialist from higher ed, a staff member and a student member of VOICE. The team will design minimum expectations and designs for the student digital portfolios.

CCR Facilitators: During parent/teacher conferences, students will use their digital portfolios to run a student led conference. At the conclusion of each year, for CCR, each student will present their portfolios to their class as the final exam. Facilitators will report out to IDEAS on the movement of their students in completing their portfolios.
